The first vocal version was done by Tony Bennett for Columbia on his "The Movie Song Album", featuring myself on the guitar and Johnny Mandel conducting the orchestra. It also received beautiful renditions by Sarah Vaughan, George Benson, Jimmy Smith, Ramsey Lewis, Shirley Horn and George Young, among countless others.*
